From the East:

Take the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) to the IL 43/Harlem Avenue exit (Exit 21B). Turn right onto Harlem and proceed one block north to Jackson Boulevard. Turn left onto Jackson and take it to Des Plaines Avenue (about one-half mile). Turn right onto Des Plaines Avenue. The Forest Park Village Hall is one block north of Jackson on the west side of the street.

From the West:

Take the Eisenhower (I-290) to the Des Plaines Avenue exit (Exit 21A). Turn left onto Des Plaines. Take it three blocks north to the Forest Park Village Hall, which is on the west side of the street.

Parking:

There is a parking lot just south of the Village Hall on Des Plaines Avenue. If this lot is full, please park on Des Plaines Avenue or the adjacent side streets, Wilcox or Adams.
